Message from Neighborhood Finance Corporation

Re: Equifax Security Breach

On September 7, 2017, Equifax announced a cybersecurity incident potentially impacting approximately 143 million U.S. consumers. The unauthorized access occurred from mid-May through July 2017. Information included names, social security numbers, birth dates, addresses, and possibly government issued ID information.

Neighborhood Finance Corporation (NFC) loan information was not included within this breach and procedures are in place to help prevent unauthorized access to your NFC loan application information.

Please be on alert for phishing emails that are supposedly from Equifax and/or telephone calls asking to verify if you were impacted. Equifax will not contact you via email or phone.

The privacy and protection of our customers' personal information is a high priority and this issue has our full attention. **NFC recommends customers visit the [Equifax website](#) for the most current information** and monitor their financial accounts closely.
